1. INTRODUCTION

The aim of the course is to take the student from a basic shooter to a more advanced operator. The principles and knowledge that we want to transfer falls in the following categories:

- Tactical mindset
- Physical Fitness
- Marksmanship
- Tactics
- Communication
- Decision making under stress / fire
- Planning
- Skills e.g. Rope work, Helicopter operations
- Exposure to the elements, e.g. Basic survival
- Tracking in the bush
- Scuba Diving

Leo Prinsloo is the lead instructor and has spent 12 years in the South African Police's Elite Anti-Terrorism unit, The Special Taskforce. Their main responsibility was hostage rescue, but also included high risk operations in the urban and bush environments.

Please note - This is a semi-restricted course. To attend this course, students must supply a covering letter (email) stating their intention. This course is designed for government organizations but may also be attended by individual soldiers, officers, medical staff or ex-service members. However as stated, students must apply by email. Once we have confirmed your request we will provide you with details on how to proceed.

2. COURSE CURRICULUM

2.1 Course Overview

An operator needs to have various skills and knowledge and knows how to apply this knowledge in demanding situations. The aspects we will cover during the course are:

- Marksmanship Basic Firearm Handling
- Tactical Firearm Handling
- House Penetration

- Unarmed Combat as part of the tactical phase
- Fitness
- Sniper
- Medical knowledge (First Aid)
- Working with a Helicopter
- Survival
- Scuba Diving

The student will be taught in all the aspects given above

The total course duration is estimated to be 46 calendar days. It is however possible to do only certain relevant sections of the course that the student would want to improve in. The basic & intermediate training is however compulsory for all students.

2.2 **Physical Fitness**

Experience has shown that no one can really fight if he / she are not fit. The students will be subjected to physical training for the duration of the course. They will be subjected to a physical fitness test at the beginning and end of the course to demonstrate the improvement during the course regarding functional fitness.

2.3 Marksmanship (Basic & Intermediate Firearm Handling)

It will be required by any operator to display good marksmanship during a critical incident. The Edge will train students in basic marksmanship applying the seven fundamentals of marksmanship, right up to tactical shooting under stress, shooting from behind cover etc.

The intermediate section teaches the student to basic handling of a firearm and includes the following:

- Magazine Changes
- Clearing Stoppages
- **Shooting Positions**



2.5 Urban Phase

This phase will focus on house penetrations and working in the urban environment. The phase is divided into a basic and more advanced phase. The basic phase covers the basic techniques and tactics, while the advanced phase covers the techniques and tactics to work in a team. The aspects that will be covered include:

Basic house penetration

- Slicing the pie
- Dynamic entry
- Step by's
- Searching principles
- Button hook

Intermediate/advance house penetration:

- Buddy pair/team movements house penetration
- Hallway clearing
- Stairs
- Multiple entry points
- Bridging techniques.
 - Special equipment
 - Bridging tools
- Use of distractions
- Multi storey buildings

2.6 Bush Phase

The techniques and tactics for the bush phase and the urban phase are the same; it is just the scenery that changes. This phase will also include some of the more advanced tactics associated with working in teams etc.

2.7 Medical First Aid

The phase of the course will look at tactical emergency medical services assistance, should either the principal or the CPO be injured. The student will learn first aid and even more than just the medical application. The student will learn to apply the medical knowledge in a tactical environment.

2.8 Helicopter Operations

A helicopter is a very versatile piece of equipment and can be used in both the urban and bush phases. The Helicopter operation is included in the TEMS scenario section. Skills included:

- LZ preparation
- Enplane / Deplane
- Dynamic deplane for a house penetration
- Casualty Evacuation via Helicopter
- Ground Air communications



Figure 1: Helicopter Operations




2.9 Sniper

The curriculum for the basic course is the following:

- Introduction to the sniping concept
- Equipment
- Rifle
- Telescopes
- Basic ballistics
- Setting up of sniper system (shooter, rifle, telescope and ammunition)
- Basic marksman ship

The curriculum for the advanced sniper builds on the foundation laid in the basic course and is the following

- Advance shooting techniques
- Range and wind estimations
- Stalking techniques- camouflage and movement
- Angle shooting
- Special shooting situations (shooting through mediums)
- Advance ballistics
- Hides
- Observation posts
- Anti-tracking

2.10 Unarmed Combat (As part of Tactical Firearm Training)

This part of the course is aimed at fighting without a firearm or when an enemy surprises you at close quarters and you don't have time to go for your firearm. The techniques taught during this segment of the course are very simplistic, doesn't require fine motor skills and is easy to remember. This is a "must do" segment that any operator must do

2.11 Bush Craft & Tracking

This part of the course is aimed at building mental toughness by exposing the student to the elements and some physical activity. This is not survival in the sense that you do not have any gear, but will teach the student various important aspects when in the bush

2.12 SCUBA Diving

We have included a SCUBA diving section at the famous Sodwana site in Northern Kwa-Zulu Natal, South Africa. Although this is recreational diving; it is another skill that the student can add to his / her toolbox.

The course scheduled to take 46 calendar days. All the aspects discussed in section 2 will be addressed during these 46 days. The details of the schedule is given in Table 1 below






Figure 2: Course Duration


